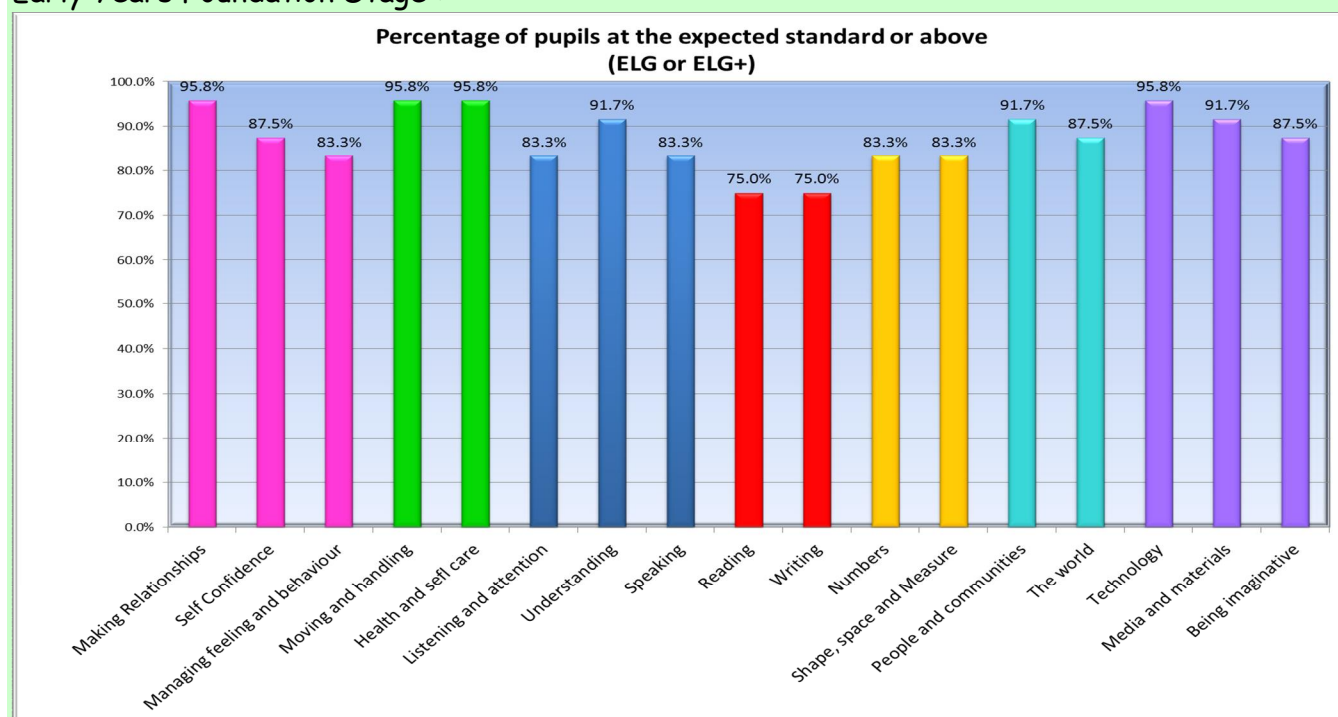
REPORTING TO PARENTS AND PERFORMANCE DATA 2016

On Monday you will have received your child's annual report. This represents our report to parents for this term. If, however, there is anything in the report that you would like to discuss with teachers, or if you have anything else you would like to talk to your class teacher about then you are welcome to make an appointment on the class door.

We now have all our performance data from the statutory Key Stage 1 and 2 tests and Year 1 Phonics checks undertaken this summer. Parents of those children in Years 1, 2 and 6 and will receive a data sheet showing these results along with their school reports on Monday. We are really delighted with how well the children have done, and are very proud of their performance.

Across the school the children have done really well this year in their achievement, as summarised in the end of key stage assessments below.

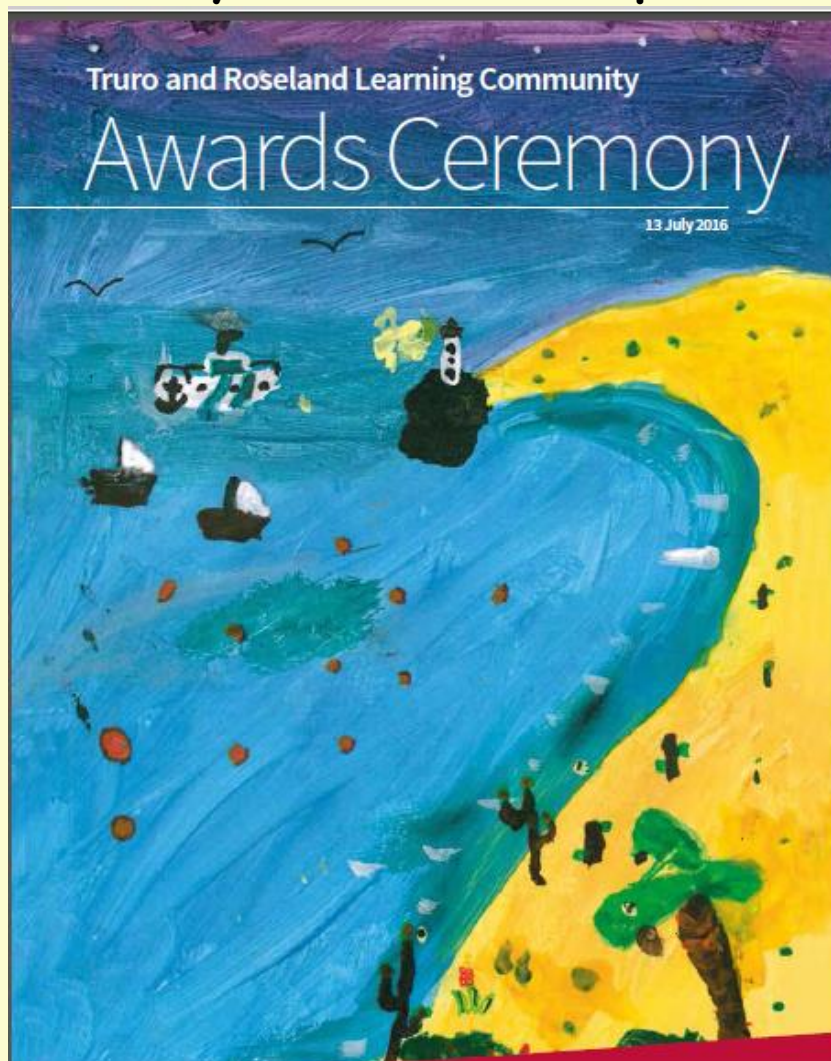
Thank you for coming along and supporting our summer fair on Friday.
