**MOVE UP DAYS** On the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of July we will also have our own 'move up' days at school, giving children the chance to get used to working in their new class groupings and with the staff who will be their new key staff. We have a very large Nursery group next year, and consequently we are running teacher - led dedicated afternoon nursery sessions all day from September to meet this demand.
