There will be a security key pad on all three doors to enable us to restrict access to the corridor and classrooms, ensuring that the children are as safe as they can possibly be whilst in school.

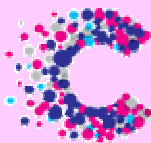
A REMINDER PLEASE that it is essential for safeguarding and fire evacuation purposes that we know who is in school at all times.
