



HOME LEARNING PLAN

Dear Parent and Carers,

Please find below the details for our home learning program for your children to use whilst our school is closed.

We have provided children with a paper copy of a home learning pack which will also be uploaded to the school website on the home learning tab. (There is a pack for Nursery, Early Years (Reception), KS1 and KS2). A pack can be collected from the school, for children who were not in school on Friday 20th March.

Each child has also been provided with a blank exercise book for completing set tasks. Books can also be collected from school with their learning pack.

A list of useful websites for home learning will be available on the school website for each key stage.

Use of Seesaw



You will need to download the Seesaw CLASS app (this is different to the Seesaw family app that we have been using to share work with you.) **This can be used on a smart phone, tablet, on a computer or laptop at** <https://web.seesaw.me/>

Children will be given a new QR code to log in (in their home learning pack) and have been taught in school how to use the app to upload their work at home.

Daily expectations

Each morning Teachers will send a daily welcome announcement to students and families and assign the following activities:

1 English task

1 maths task

1 foundation subject

- The English and maths activities will be set from pages in the home learning packs or from activities assigned on Seesaw.
- The foundation subject activity can be chosen by the child from their 'foundation subject grid' which will be sent with the learning pack. This will also be available on the school website.
- Children should upload their work to Seesaw daily by 3:15p.m. Teachers will respond to the completed activities by the next working school day. This might include liking or commenting on their tasks. *Teachers will not comment on every task that the children upload - but will comment at least once a day for every child.*
- Teachers will set work for each day that the children should be in school and will also respond to the children's work on these days. We will not be setting or responding to home learning during the planned Easter break.
- Daily expectations will of course be different for our Nursery and reception children, which classteachers will communicate separately.
